

Agreement and conditions for borrowing Cat in the Hat suit (including Thing One and Thing Two costumes) owned by the Delaware State Education Association.

1. The Borrower must be a DSEA member.
2. The purpose of the Cat's appearance, as well as the date, must be approved by DSEA staff Pam Nichols or Susan Keller. The Cat's appearance must be directly related to promoting reading amongst children and their families.
3. The Borrower agrees that they will give DSEA credit for lending the suit (Cat in the Hat and Things One and Two costumes are courtesy of the Delaware State Education Association) in all promotional material, such as on flyers/posters which go to students' homes.
4. The Borrower and person to wear the Cat suit must come to DSEA to try on with either Pam Nichols or Susan Keller to make sure he/she is the right size; can stand the heat; and will not become panicky/claustrophobic. DSEA staff must be satisfied that the person to wear the suit is able to do it satisfactorily.
5. The Borrower must pick up and deliver box back to DSEA at times stipulated/agreed upon with Pam or Susan. Transportation needs to be adequate to fit the box comfortably. The Box is approximately 4feet long and 3 feet wide and two feet high.
6. The Borrower must agree to the rules regarding comportment of the Cat (no talking; only 20 min. max at a time; no appearing for a commercial purpose; must have at least one other person with Cat to help with suit, guide, fend off anyone who wants to touch, yank, etc.)
7. The Borrower agrees that if the Cat in the Hat suit is lost, stolen or damaged, he/she is responsible to DSEA for its replacement: **\$2,800**. The Borrower agrees that if the Thing One and Thing Two costumes are lost, stolen or damaged, he/she is responsible to DSEA for their replacement: \$125 (including wigs) or \$75 for red suits only.
8. DSEA has the final say on whether or not a member's request meets these stipulations.
